**No Child Left Behind School Choice Option Information**

Under the federal No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act of 2011, Title I, Part A campuses identified a “in need of improvement” for not making Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) for two consecutive years must give parents of students on those campuses an option to request to another public school within the district that is not identified for school improvement. Also, the status of the transfers must be made available to the parents and community.

Two campuses in LISD are identified as in need of improvement. Those campuses are listed below with the status of the transfer requests:

**Forest Park Middle School:**

\*\* Because LISD is under a court-imposed desegregation order that prohibits intra-district except in case involving “minority-to-majority transfers, some students were legally prohibited from transfer unless the court modifies the order.
